# Risk-Assessed Management Plan (RAMP)

## Toowoomba AFC – Liquor Permit Application

### 1. Venue and Club Details

- **Club Name:** Toowoomba Australian Football Club (TAFC)
  - **Address:** Rockville Park. Tor St, Wilsonton Heights Qld 4350
  - **Liquor Licence Type:** Restricted Liquor Permit (Qld)
  - **Licensee Name:** Daniel Fraser (President)
  - **Primary Club Activities:** Australian rules football training, matches, and social events
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### 2. Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) Initiatives

TAFC is committed to ensuring the responsible service of alcohol by:

- ✓ Ensuring all bar staff and volunteers serving alcohol is under the general supervision of a person holding a current **RSA certificate**.
  - ✓ Displaying RSA signage, including "Under 18 – No Alcohol" and responsible drinking messages.
  - ✓ Enforcing **ID checks** – no service to minors or intoxicated persons.
  - ✓ Promoting **low-alcohol and non-alcoholic beverages** at all events.
  - ✓ Providing **free water** at all times.
  - ✓ Limiting **alcohol sale hours** to Thursday 6-8pm and Saturday 12:30-8:30pm
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### 3. Strategies to Prevent Intoxication & Disorderly Conduct

To maintain a safe and responsible drinking environment, TAFC will:

- ✓ Refuse service to any person showing signs of intoxication.
  - ✓ Train staff to recognize early signs of intoxication and intervene appropriately.
  - ✓ Promote responsible consumption by limiting drink purchases per transaction.
  - ✓ Maintain a **Safe Transport Plan**, encouraging the use of designated drivers and taxi services.
  - ✓ Provide adequate **security or RSA marshals** during major events.
  - ✓ Ensure **licensed security staff (if required by event size)** monitor crowd behaviour.
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### 4. Underage Drinking Prevention

To prevent underage drinking at club events:

- ◆ Strict **ID checks** will be conducted before serving alcohol.
  - ◆ No alcohol will be sold to or for minors, with clear signage displayed.
  - ◆ Minors attending events will be required to stay in supervised areas.
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## 5. Provision of Food

T AFC ensures that a wide range of hot and cold food options is available at all event times to encourage responsible alcohol consumption and support patron wellbeing.

- ✓ The club's canteen will operate **during all licensed events**, offering substantial food options, including meals and snacks.
  - ✓ The canteen will be managed by a trained operator holding a Food Handling Certificate to comply with food safety regulations.
  - ✓ Food service will be **actively promoted** alongside alcohol service, with clear signage directing patrons to food options.
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## 6. Alcohol Advertising and Promotion

T AFC will ensure that all alcohol-related promotions:

- Do **not** encourage binge drinking or rapid alcohol consumption.
  - Are **not** targeted at minors or vulnerable individuals.
  - Promote **responsible drinking messages**.
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## 7. Noise and Community Considerations

Toowoomba AFC respects its local community and will:

- ◆ Adhere to **local noise restrictions**, ensuring events comply with council regulations.
  - ◆ Display signage asking patrons to **leave quietly** and respect neighbours.
  - ◆ Conduct regular **venue clean-ups** to maintain a safe and clean environment.
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## 8. Incident and Complaint Management

T AFC will:

- ✓ Record all alcohol-related incidents in an **Incident Register**.
  - ✓ Train staff to handle intoxicated or aggressive patrons appropriately.
  - ✓ Provide a **designated RSA Officer** at larger events to oversee compliance.
  - ✓ Address any community complaints regarding alcohol service in a timely manner.
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## 9. Compliance with Liquor Licensing Laws




T AFC is fully committed to complying with Queensland's **Liquor Act 1992** and all licensing conditions, including:

- ✓ Only serving alcohol during **approved hours**.
- ✓ Not permitting alcohol consumption outside **designated areas**.
- ✓ Ensuring all **RSA-trained staff** are aware of their responsibilities.
- ✓ Keeping all necessary **records and logs** for compliance purposes.

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## 10. Safe Transport Plan

To ensure the safety of patrons, TAFC will:

-  Promote taxi and rideshare services at events.
-  Encourage **designated driver programs**.
-  Provide information on **public transport options** where available.
